The University of Queensland is established under the *University of Queensland Act 1998*, and is a body corporate established under the *University of Queensland Act 1910*.

Functions

The University:

• directs and manages the affairs of the University;

• provides and manages the University's financial resources;

• provides and manages the University's physical resources;

• provides and manages the University's human resources;

• provides and manages the University's information resources;

• provides and manages the University's research resources;

• provides and manages the University's teaching resources;

• provides and manages the University's student resources;

• provides and manages the University's community resources;

• provides and manages the University's international resources;

• provides and manages the University's legal resources;

• provides and manages the University's administrative resources;

• provides and manages the University's information technology resources;

• provides and manages the University's sports resources;
